## **AGBU President Sam Simonian Continues Touchpoints Tour with a Visit to California Armenian Communities**



led by Student Council members, demonstrating the strength of student leadership at MDS. Dr. Natalie Berberian, Director of Curriculum, Instruction & Innovation, presented an overview of the school's library, and AGBU MDS Board Chair and Western Region (WR) Chair Kevork Zoryan highlighted the AGBU Innovation Studios, modeled after the inaugural site in Pasadena. The campus visit concluded with a reception hosted by the school's Hospitality Committee, a dedicated group of volunteer mothers, held in the Nazarian Gym foyer.

The Armenians of Greater Los Angeles and Fresno have long been on AGBU President Sam Simonian's list of key communities to visit, as he pursues his ambitious agenda to meet in person with AGBU local leadership and community members across the world.

From March 13-15, he and his delegation, including his wife Sylva, AGBU Honorary President Berge Setrakian, members of the Central Board, Council of Trustees, Strategic Advisory Council, and Central Office management, took the opportunity to explore what is the world's largest Armenian community in the Diaspora, after Russia.

### **Visit to Greater Los Angeles**

On March 13, the AGBU delegation received a warm welcome at the AGBU Manoogian-Demirdjian School (MDS), which was celebrating its 50th anniversary that same weekend. Archbishop Fr. Shnork Demirjian,

pastor of Saint Peter Armenian Apostolic Church, former Principal Hagop Hagopian, and former Vice Principal Dr. Ellie Andreassian were also in attendance.

The day began with an assembly in the school's Nazarian Sports Gymnasium, featuring remarks by President Simonian, MDS leadership, Student Council members and other guests, including Consul General of Armenia in Los Angeles Anna Avetisyan and Councilmember Adrin Nazarian, as well as Armenian dance performances. Members of the school administration then led a guided tour of the campus, which included the school's newly acquired property across the street — a significant milestone in MDS's continued growth.

Among the highlights were a visit to the Artemis Nazarian Preschool, where the school's youngest performed, and a tour of the newly established Collaborative Learning Center (CLC),

That evening, chapter, committee, and YP leaders from across the greater Los Angeles area convened at the AGBU Vatche and Tamar Manoukian Cultural Center for an intimate roundtable discussion. Led by WR Chair Zoryan and WR Executive Director Gohar Stambolyan, the meeting provided an opportunity for regional leaders to present updates, key initiatives, and share the breadth of activities taking place in the community.

The cultural center was transformed for the occasion into an elegant reception space, complete with live music and a commemorative cake marking AGBU's own 120th anniversary, a reminder that MDS's milestone is part of a much longer story of institutional commitment to the Armenian nation and people.

On March 15, a smaller delegation traveled North to the Central Valley to meet with committee members of the AGBU Greater Fresno Chapter and learn more about the local Armenian community and AGBU's presence there since 1910, as well as current opportunities for regional and global collaboration. Afterward, they visited the AGBU Center and explored Fresno's Armenian sites—a fitting conclusion to a weekend that

The centerpiece of the weekend was the AGBU MDS 50th Anniversary Gala on March 14, which drew nearly 900 guests for a celebratory evening, raising over \$4 million in support of the school's future. Attendees included supporters, families, alumni, AGBU leadership from across the globe, dignitaries, and community representatives, all united in celebration of five decades of educational excellence and a lifetime of impact.

School Board Chair Zoryan and Head of School David Ghoogasian expressed words of gratitude and honored distinguished members of the MDS community for their decades of dedication and service.

President Simonian, in his speech, remarked on the meaning of the milestone occasion: "Fifty years is more than a milestone, it's a statement. Schools don't reach 50 years because of buildings and endowments alone. They reach 50 years because of people; teachers who care deeply about their students, parents who make sacrifices so their children can learn and grow, and administrators and volunteers who dedicate countless hours to guiding the institution forward."



AGBU Honorary President Setrakian delivered a special tribute to Sinan Sinanian, longtime former MDS School Board Chair, former AGBU Central Board member, and current member of Council of Trustees. ## A Triumphant Musical Tribute Honors the Legacy of Alan Hovhaness at St. Leon Armenian Cathedral, CA



In a stirring celebration of faith, culture, and musical genius, the sanctuary of St. Leon (Gheventians) Armenian Cathedral was filled to capacity for a historic orchestral concert commemorating the enduring legacy of the legendary 20th-century composer Alan Hovhaness.

Held under the auspices of His Eminence Archbishop Hovnan Derderian, Primate of the Western Diocese of the Armenian Church of North America, and under the generous patronage of Mr. Arman Narinyan and Mrs. Suzanna Azizian, the concert was dedicated in honor of His Excellency Narek Mkrtchyan, Ambassador of the Republic of Armenia to the United States.

Presented by the Stewardship Committee of the Western Diocese, the evening brought together clergy, dignitaries, benefactors, and music lovers in a profound tribute to one of the most distinctive voices in 20th-century classical music, whose works bridge East and West, sacred and symphonic traditions.

Among the distinguished guests in attendance were Ambassador Narek Mkrtchyan; Consul General of Armenia in Los Angeles Anna Avetisyan; Japan's Consulate General Advisor Jennifer Uryak; Diocesan Council Chairman Derik Ghookasian, accompanied by his spouse Adrineh; and the son of Alan Hovhaness Mr. William Holst, who was accompanied by his spouse Colleen. Numerous diocesan benefactors, Cathedral godfathers, and devoted supporters were also present, underscoring the communal significance

of the occasion.

Opening the program, Derik Ghookasian delivered welcoming remarks, emphasizing the Western Diocese's steadfast commitment to preserving and celebrating Armenian cultural identity through exceptional artistic initiatives.

The orchestra was masterfully conducted by Maestro Raffi Mikaelian, Artistic Director and Conductor of the Paros Chamber Choir and a conductor at the National Opera and Ballet Theater of Armenia. Under his baton, the evening unfolded as a rich tapestry of Hovhaness's most beloved works.



The program featured Armenian Rhapsody No. 1, Alleluia & Fugue, and Prayer of St. Gregory, with a moving trumpet solo by Andrew Rodman. Audiences were further captivated by Armenian Rhapsody No. 2 and the evocative piano concerto Lousadzak, featuring pianist Leon Thomasian.

A highlight of the evening was Avak the Healer, Part V, featuring the luminous soprano Arsine Zargaryan, who also delivered a heartfelt rendition of the beloved Armenian folk song Yar Nazani.

The concert was enriched by the participation of the Shnorhali Choir under the direction of Deacon Artur Vardanyan. Their performances included Bahaban Amenayni, a cherished Armenian hymn inspired by the writings of St. Nerses Shnorhali, as well as Der Lour, reflecting the profound liturgical heritage of the Armenian Church.



The evening culminated in a joyful and uplifting choral finale, Jesus Christ Is Risen Today from the Easter Cantata. Celebrating the Resurrection of Christ, the timeless hymn resounded through the cathedral, proclaiming a message of hope, renewal, and triumph.

In his closing remarks, Archbishop Hovnan Derderian expressed heartfelt gratitude to Ambassador Narek Mkrtchyan and Consul General Anna Avetisyan for their gracious presence, to patrons Mr. Narinyan and Mrs. Azizian for their generosity, and to the Stewardship Committee for their unwavering dedication to advancing the mission of the Diocese. He also extended special appreciation to Mr. and Mrs. Holst for their inspiring attendance, to the gifted performers for their artistic excellence, and to all who gathered in celebration of the rich musical and cultural heritage embodied in the works of Alan Hovhaness.

Proceeds from the concert will directly benefit the Stewardship Program of the Western Diocese, supporting the education and formation of the next generation of Diocesan clergy.

## Moscow Warns of Possible Air Link Disruption if Armenia Joins the EU, Says Upcoming Elections Are Also of Interest



Russian officials have issued fresh remarks on Armenia's possible European integration, warning of potential consequences for bilateral ties while also stressing Moscow's interest in Armenia's upcoming elections.

Russian Deputy Prime Minister Alexey Overchuk warned that if Armenia joins the European Union, it could lose its air connection with Russia.

"At present, there is no air communication with European Union countries, which means that if

Armenia becomes an EU member, we would no longer have air communication with Armenia," Overchuk said.

He emphasized that Armenian citizens should be aware of the possible consequences of Yerevan's decision to move closer to the EU.

"This may sound very harsh, but we want the people of Armenia to understand what could happen if this takes place, since decisions have already been made to move closer to the European Union," the Russian deputy prime minister added.

At the same time, Overchuk noted that the final consequences of Armenia's potential EU accession remain unclear.

Separately, Kremlin spokesperson Dmitry Peskov said Russia has every right to discuss Armenia's upcoming elections, citing the deep historical ties between the two countries.



"Armenia is a country close to us, with which we share deep historical roots. The large Armenian diaspora living here numbers more than 2 million people, and therefore Yerevan's priorities are of great interest in Moscow," Peskov said.

The statements underscore Moscow's continued close attention to Armenia's geopolitical direction, particularly as Yerevan weighs closer ties with Europe ahead of an important political period.

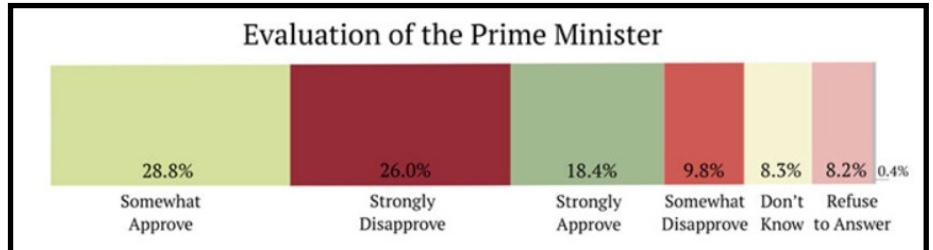
## New EVN Report Poll Shows Civil Contract Strengthening Ahead of June 7 Elections



A new nationwide voter survey by EVN's Report's Armenian Election Study (ArmES) shows Armenia's ruling Civil Contract party strengthening its position ahead of the June 7 parliamentary elections, while the opposition remains fragmented and unable to consolidate support.

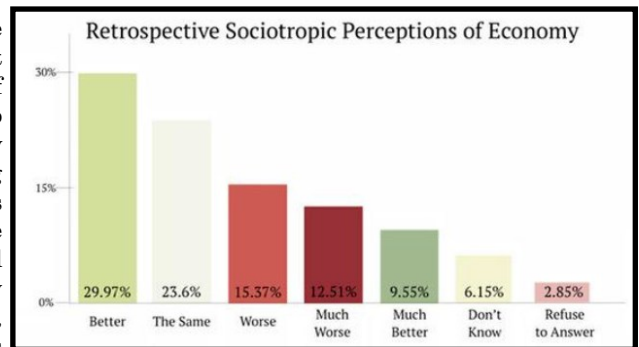
The second wave of polling, conducted between February 23 and March 31, 2026, surveyed 911 respondents nationwide and found that Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan's approval rating rose sharply to 47.2%, up from 36% in the first wave, moving his performance rating into positive territory. At the same time, the share of voters who believe Armenia is heading in the right direction increased to 41.2%, while those saying the country is on the wrong track dropped to 33.3%.

The findings suggest growing public confidence in the government's management of security, the economy, and foreign policy developments, including positive reactions to the TRIPP initiative, the visit of U.S. Vice President J.D. Vance, and the government's handling of the regional crisis involving Iran. These factors appear to be translating into a measurable electoral boost for the incumbent party.



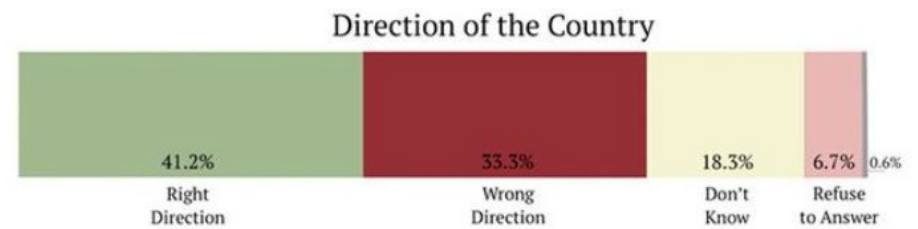
Despite leading the field, Civil Contract still appears short of the threshold needed to form a single-party government, meaning coalition scenarios remain possible. The opposition field continues to be led by Strong Armenia, though its support has largely stagnated, while the Armenia Alliance remains below the parliamentary threshold. Pro-Western opposition parties also continue to trail far behind, with none currently positioned to enter parliament.

The survey also found improving public



also said Armenia's security environment has improved, even amid heightened regional tensions.

Overall, the second wave of EVN Report's polling points to a clear momentum shift in favor of the ruling party, with undecided voters also showing a modest move toward



sentiment on the economy, with 39.5% saying the economy is better than a year ago and 40.4% expecting it to improve further over the next year. Meanwhile, a majority of respondents

## Voice of Peace Music Fest in Yerevan to feature Imany, Outlandish, Iveta Mukuchyan and other stars

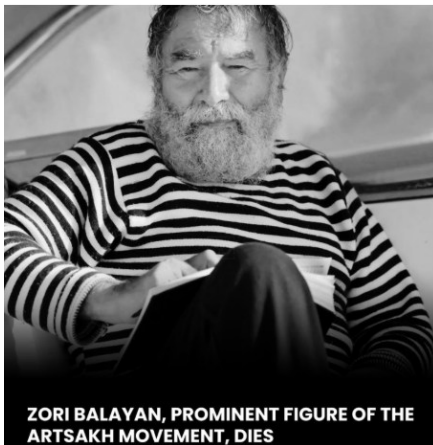
The Voice of Peace Music Fest will take place in Yerevan's Republic Square on April 25, which is marked as Citizens' Day in Armenia.

## Zori Balayan has died on April 6 at the age of 91



ZORI BALAYAN, PROMINENT FIGURE OF THE ARTSAKH MOVEMENT, DIES

Writer, publicist, physician, and public and political figure Zori Balayan has died at the age of 91.

Balayan was born on February 10, 1935, in Stepanakert. A prominent intellectual and active participant in the Karabakh movement, he also served as a deputy of the Supreme Soviet of the USSR. Throughout his literary career, he occasionally wrote under the pen name Hayk Karabakhsi.

From 1992 to 1995, he was a deputy of the Supreme Council of the Republic of Artsakh. During the most critical years of the First Artsakh War, Balayan was actively involved in shaping military-political strategies and was frequently present on the front lines. He also played a key role in organizing humanitarian assistance to Artsakh from abroad.
