Armenian PM to Take the Podium at UN General Assembly



Armenian **Prime** Minister Nikol Pashinyan.is deliver speech at the 80th session of the United **Nations** General Assembly (UNGA) in New York. It is likely that Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan will be accompanied by his wife,

Anna Hakobyan, and other high-ranking diplomatic and political staff.

Pashinyan is the ninth speaker and will deliver his address on September 26.

The UNGA High-Level Week is scheduled to take place at the organization's headquarters on September 23-30, with leaders from around the world convening to discuss global challenges and cooperation. Traditionally, the session opens with an

introductory speech by Brazil's President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva, followed by an address from US President Donald Trump.

The 80th UNGA session will bring together presidents, prime ministers, and foreign ministers from member states to deliberate on pressing international issues, marking a key moment for diplomacy and multilateral dialogue.

Following the services a reception was held at the St. Mary's Toufayan Hall. In a relaxed and informal atmosphere the




faithful had a chance to meet and greet the Primate and congratulated Fr. Voskan and his wife, Olga.

Turkish President Erdogan receives Greek orthodox patriarch of Jerusalem




Foreign Minister Fidan, Communications Director Duran, Chief Advisor Kilic also attend meeting.

Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan on Saturday, September 13, 2025 received Theophilos Giannopoulos, the Greek Orthodox patriarch of Jerusalem, and his accompanying delegation.

Foreign Minister Hakan Fidan, Communications Director Burhanettin Duran, and the president's Chief Advisor Akif Cagatay Kilic were also present at the Presidential Dolmabahce Office. Erdogan and Patriarch Giannopoulos exchanged gifts at the end of the meeting.

No further information about the meeting was provided by the officials.

New Book on Canon Law



Α the canons of the Armenian Church by Archbishop Norayr Bogharian (1904 -1997) now available the to general public. The

author is a distinguished theologian and renowned scholar of Armenian Church history and philology, and the author of the multi-volume catalogue of the manuscripts of the Armenian Patriarchate of Jerusalem, as well as authoritative books and numerous articles in the Armenian press.

The original Armenian text on the canons of the Armenian Church is translated into English by Rev. Fr. Arshen Aivazian, a student of the author and himself a student of history and the liturgy of the Armenian Church. He has translated many liturgical texts into English and the Armenian vernacular. He is a former dean of St. Nersess Seminary and has served in parishes in the Eastern and Western Dioceses of North America. The book contains the translation of the Canon Law course taught by Archbishop Norayr Bogharian in the early 1960s at the St. James Seminary of the Armenian Patriarchate of Jerusalem and is being published under the title Introduction to the Canonical Tradition of the Armenian Church.

After completing the course on Canon Law, a few students, Fr. Arshen among them, received permission from the author to transcribe his original Armenian lecture notes. The English edition is supplemented with explanatory notes by the translator, intended to introduce readers to the historical background and evolution of the Canon Law of the Armenian Church. It is dedicated to the 1700th anniversary of the first Ecumenical Council of Nicaea, convened in 325 AD that defined the Orthodox faith in the Nicaean Creed. It also coincides with the 60th anniversary of Fr. Arshen Aivazian's ordination to the holy priesthood.

The project is sponsored by Anton and Laura Sahazizian and Stephen and Lily Mekenian. The book will be available for sale and distribution at the end of August and may be ordered here. The book price is \$25 plus shipping and handling.

Pope Leo XIV receives Karekin II, Catholicos of All Armenians, in an audience on Tuesday at Castel Gandolfo



Karekin II, Catholicos of All Armenians, was received in audience by Pope Leo XIV on Tuesday morning, the first meeting between the two. Since his election twenty-five years ago, Catholicos Karekin has met with St. John Paul II, Benedict XVI, and Francis.

Tuesday's audience took place at Villa Barberini, the papal residence in Castel Gandolfo, where Pope Leo has been since Monday evening.

The meeting unfolded in "a fraternal and cordial atmosphere, during which



various ecclesial issues were discussed, Patriarch the Armenian emphasized the fate of the Armenians Artsakh," Archbishop Khajag Barsamian, representative Armenian Apostolic Church Etchmiadzin to the Holy See, explained in a phone interview with Vatican News.

The Patriarch extended an invitation to the Pope to visit Armenia, Archbishop Barsamian continued, and both reaffirmed the necessity of peace—peace founded on justice, as Catholicos Karekin emphasized.



The Catholicos shared with the Pope an update on the situation that had arisen following the military



operations against Artsakh. He underscored the importance of the Pope's appeals to end the conflict and to re-establish peace.

"Soul on Fire" is based on the true

story of Dr. Aivazian, in the movie as Dr. Kendrick Khachikian , an Armenian-American plastic surgeon who lived in Lebanon.

In 2006, while working in a makeshift clinic in Lebanon, Dr. Aivazian treated John O'Leary, an American photojournalist who had been severely burned in a roadside bombing during a conflict. The burns were incredibly extensive and complex, requiring a level of skill and dedication that was rarely seen.

The burns were deeply embedded and required. multiple surgeries, complex skin grafting, and constant immaculate care to prevent infection

Dr. Aivazian and his team worked tirelessly, often operating over 24 hours at a time, to save O'Leary's life.

The situation was very difficult, with limited resources and high risk complications.

The title "Soul on Fire" reflects the immense emotional and physical toll the operation took on Dr. Aivazian - the intensity of his dedication and the personal sacrifice he made. It's also a reference to the intense physical suffering of John O'Leary.

October 10 is the premiere of the movie.

EU to provide Armenia with over €200 million under Resilience and Growth Plan



The European Union will provide more than €200 million to Armenia under the second stage of the Resilience and Growth Plan, European Commissioner for Enlargement Marta Kos announced at a press conference in Yerevan.

She said the funding would boost investments in connectivity, resilience and business development.

"This is evidence of Armenia's commitment to a clear reform agenda. This also demonstrates your clear

commitment to implementing reforms in key areas," Kos stated.

She noted that the EU is ready to support Armenia in transport, digitalization, trade, energy and infrastructure projects, in line with the "Crossroads of Peace" project.

Kos emphasized that investing in the peace process remains one of the EU's priorities.

"When we address economic developments and relations, we often forget how important it is to live in peace. Europe is founded on peace and is a partner for peace. The South Caucasus and Armenia are a very important part of the changes that will change the situation in Europe and the region," she said.

The EU Commissioner highlighted that more than €2.5 billion in investment has already been mobilized for



Armenia since 2021. She also mentioned an agreement signed with the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) to improve customs operations and to support refugees and their host communities.

Kos added that the EU is actively working on developing an international and interregional connectivity agenda, linking Europe with Central Asia through the South Caucasus, including Armenia.

325th anniversary of St. Lazar Mekhitarian



A concert in celebration of the "325th anniversary of St. Lazar Mekhitarian" in honor of the 325th birth anniversary of Mkhitar Sebastatsi, the founder of the Mekhitarist Congregation of Armenian Catholic monks, took place on September 7, 2025. Mekhitarists

have their primary monastery on the island of San Lazzaro degli Armeni, located in the Venetian Lagoon.




