'Merely a matter of time': Armenian PM sees no obstacles to normalization with Türkiye



Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan believes that there is no obstacle to establishing diplomatic relations and opening the borders between Armenia and Türkiye, and that its implementation is "merely a matter of time"

The Armenian Prime Minister made the remarks during the Leadership at the Crossroads: Navigating Power and Stability in a Fragmented World discussion at the Paris Peace Forum, when asked about the impact of the initialed peace deal between Armenia and Azerbaijan on the normalization process with Türkiye.

"I believe that the establishment of diplomatic relations between Armenia and Türkiye and the opening of the border

between the two countries is merely a matter of time, as there are currently no major obstacles to either opening the border or establishing diplomatic relations. I think it will happen, but how quickly it will happen is another question and a different matter. We are reaching a point where we will have full diplomatic relations, open borders, economic and political cooperation, and will be normal neighbors." the Prime Minister of Armenia stated. Prime Minister Pashinyan stated that this moment is approaching very soon, but he cannot specify the exact timing of its implementation.

The initialing of the Armenia -Azerbaijan peace deal in Washington provided a much more positive momentum in Armenia's relations with Türkiye, the Prime Minister said.

The Armenian and Turkish governments have been engaged in negotiations aimed normalizing at relations. establishing diplomatic ties, and reopening the land border, which has been closed by Türkiye since the early 1990s.

Special envoys from both sides have held multiple meetings, and several meetings between Armenian PM Nikol Pashinyan and Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan have also taken place.

The dialogue between Armenia and Türkiye continues in an intensive format, and tangible results are expected in the near future, Foreign Minister Ararat Mirzoyan has said.

"We are having very intensive dialogue with Türkiye. I can also share my stance and assessment: I am very optimistic in this regard and believe that, in the near future, we should see tangible results in the Armenia—Türkiye dialogue," the foreign minister said at a parliamentary committee hearing on the 2026 budget bill.

## Armenian Church Representatives Participate in International "Daring Peace" Conference in Rome



The International Meeting "Daring Peace", organized by the Community of Sant'Egidio, convened in Rome from 26 to 28 October, drawing religious leaders, dignitaries, and over ten thousand participants from Europe and other continents, among them many young people to promote dialogue and peace among nations.

Representing His Holiness Karekin II, Catholicos ofA11 Armenians, Archbishop Khaiag Barsamian. Pontifical Legate of Western Europe and Representative of the Armenian Church to the Holy See, along with Father Karekin Hampartzoumian, Director of Ecumenical Relations of the Mother See of Holy Etchmiadzin, actively participated in this important conference. The Armenian Patriarch of Istanbul, His Beatitude Archbishop Sahak Mashalyan was also invited to join this significant gathering.

Distinguished guests included the President of Italy and the Queen of Belgium, both of whom addressed participants at the inauguration ceremony. A highlight of the conference was a Christian Prayer

Service held at the historic Colosseum, presided over by Pope Leo XIV, who also attended the closing ceremony.

On Monday, 27 October, Archbishop Khajag Barsamian addresses one of the forums on the theme: "Standing Against Evil: The Martyrs of Our Time".

In his presentation Archbishop Barsamian emphasized that for Armenians, martyrdom is not merely an abstract concept but a powerful testament to faith and witness. He stated, "To remember our martyrs is not to glorify suffering, but to honor a life freely offered in fidelity to God and love for one's neighbor."

The Archbishop recounted the tragic history of the Armenian Genocide, which saw the loss of 1.5 million lives, underscoring the enduring spirit of hope and resilience that defines the Armenian Church. He highlighted the canonization of the Holy Martyrs of 1915, asserting that "love is stronger than death" and that genuine memory serves as a form of justice.

Focusing on contemporary issues, Barsamian recognized the ongoing suffering of Christian communities in the Middle East and other parts of the world, as well as marginalized groups facing persecution worldwide. He called for united action across faiths, emphasizing that "evil isolates and



divides; the martyrs call us to solidarity."

The Archbishop outlined dimensions of standing against evil, urging attendees to remember truthfully, witness together, choose spiritual weapons, bind wounds, unite mercy with justice, and form consciences for peace. His reflections called for practical steps, including providing shelter and education for vulnerable. and fostering dialogue and reconciliation.

He concluded with a powerful prayer from St. Gregory of Narek, encapsulating the conference's spirit of hope and commitment to peace. "May the memory of the righteous be a blessing, and may their witness make us worthy of the name Christian," he prayed.

The conference served as a platform for dialogue among diverse faith traditions, reinforcing the importance of compassion, humanitarian action, and the pursuit of justice in an era marked by conflict and division.

## European Parliament ready to support Armenia's 'historic journey' toward EU membership, says Vice President Younous Omarjee



The European Parliament is ready to support Armenia in the process of joining the European Union, Younous Omarjee, Vice-President of the European Parliament, said in his remarks delivered on behalf of Roberta Metsola, President of the European Parliament, at the 12th Ordinary Session of the Euronest Parliamentary Assembly in Yerevan.

Omarjee said that Armenia's recent decisions demonstrate the country's clear choice towards the European family.

He described the EU bill as a "historic law".

"Armenia's decisions, especially the recent ones, are extremely important. Armenia has adopted a historic law, sending a clear and strong message, declaring that it sees its future as part of Europe. This is not just a symbolic gesture, but a strategic choice to join the family of European democracies. The European Parliament is ready to support Armenia on this historic journey if you decide to officially submit your candidacy for EU membership," Vice President Younous

Omarjee said.

He noted that Armenia's European direction aligns with the practical cooperation established between the EU and Armenia.

"In addition to political statements, there is also a real, tangible partnership—especially in the fields of economy and the Eastern Partnership investment programs. We are combining our efforts to create new jobs, modern infrastructure, and opportunities for young Armenians. When the European Union and Armenia move forward together, they can build a more prosperous and just future for everyone," he added.

#### U.S. to Establish First Working Groups with Armenia and Azerbaijan by Year's End



The U.S. government plans to establish the first working groups with Armenia and Azerbaijan by the end of this year, according to the Azerbaijani news agency Report, citing the U.S.

Department of State's press service.

"The United States is committed to implementing the historic declarations and memorandums of understanding signed in Washington on August 8," the State Department stated, welcoming the recent substantive dialogue and practical steps between Azerbaijan and Armenia concerning border and delimitation, demining, the infrastructure development of supporting the TRIPP initiative.

The State Department also praised

Azerbaijan's recent decision to allow the transit of goods through its territory to Armenia, as well as the meeting held in Yerevan between representatives of the two countries' civil societies.

"The United States' initiatives, along with these efforts, will attract private investment and usher in a new era of prosperity for Azerbaijan, Armenia, and other countries," the State Department told the Azerbaijani agency.

The commission is headed by Deputy Prime Minister Mher Grigoryan. Its members include Deputy Foreign Minister Vahan Kostanyan, Foreign Minister Ararat Mirzoyan's wife Gohar Abaiyan, and several officials.

Gohar Abajyan was recently appointed director of Enterprise Armenia ("Investment Support Center" Foundation).
